Office for National Statistics Release 2011 Conception Data

The Office for National Statistics (ONS) released annual conception data earlier this week. The number of conceptions to women under 18 and to girls under 16 both fell by 10% compared to 2010. The under 18 conception rate for 2011 is the lowest since 1969 at 30.9 conceptions per thousand women aged 15-17. Conception rates in 2011 increased for women aged 30 years and over, stayed the same for women aged

25-29 and decreased for women aged under 25.

Unprotected Nation: The Financial & Economic Impact of Restricted Sexual Health Services

This new report, commissioned by Brook and FPA (Family Planning Association), projects the economic and social impacts from reduced or restricted access to contraceptive and sexual health services. It demonstrates how service cuts and restrictions could lead to a significant rise in sexually transmitted infections and unintended pregnancies, with the potential to add an additional £612million to NHS costs by 2020.
