The PHOF data update for May 2013 has been published by the Department of Health (DH) and Public Health England (PHE). Data have been updated for the following indicators relevant to sexual health: under 18 conceptions (2.04); Chlamydia diagnoses (3.02) and HPV vaccination coverage (3.03xii). NCSP 3Cs (&HIV) Programme

The National Chlamydia Screening Programme (NCSP) has developed the 3Cs (& HIV) programme to strengthen sexual health work being delivered by general practices. The 3Cs (&HIV) programme focuses on encouraging the delivery of a basic sexual health offer during routine consultations with 15-24 year olds: a chlamydia screen, signposting information on contraception and free condoms, plus the offer of an HIV test for new practice registrants over 16 in high HIV prevalence areas.
